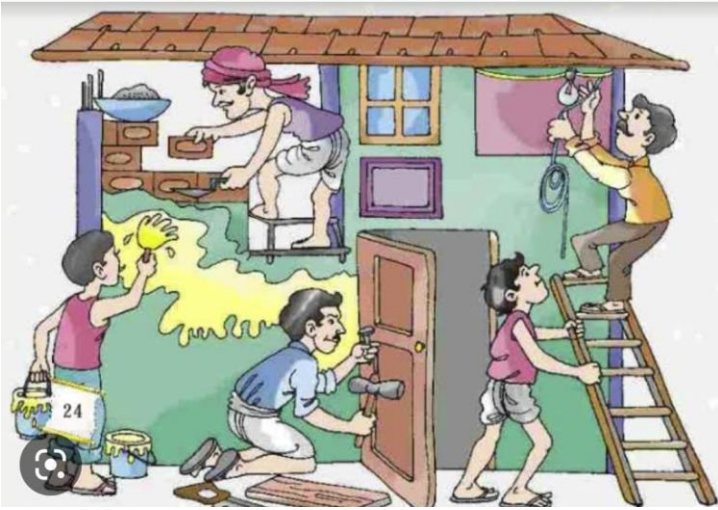

Vitamin A keeps the eyes and skin healthy and helps protect against infection. Vitamin A is found in milk, eggs and vegetables such as pumpkin, carrots, spinach and broccoli. Vitamin B is good for the nervous system and is found in green vegetables. Vitamin C helps the immune system by fighting infection. Vitamin C is found in citrus fruits like Strawberry, Kiwi, Guava, Chili and Tomato. Vitamin K helps in clotting of blood. Beans, peas, turnips contain vitamin K. Calcium is essential for healthy teeth, bones, hair and nails. Potassium regulates muscles and nerves and prevents high blood pressure. All vegetables contain potassium. Iron is essential for red blood cells. Iron is found in vegetables like spinach, leeks and mushrooms. Vitamin C also helps in the absorption of iron in the body. We should avoid the loss of vitamins by applying the peel. Vegetables should not be soaked in water as it leads to deficiency of Vitamin B and C.

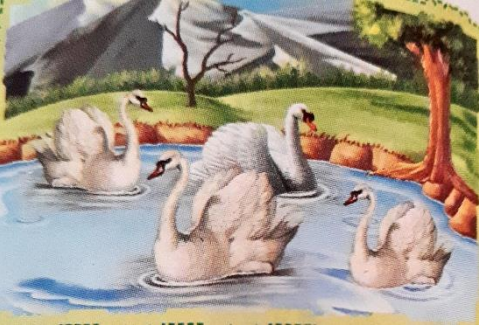
